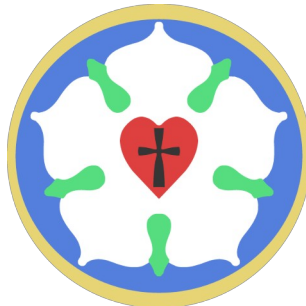

A 7 session study on ***The Psalms*** will continue Wednesday, November 8th at 10am at the church.

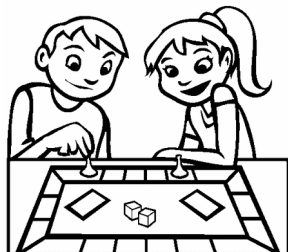
Everyone is welcome to attend.
